
There are currently over 20 Technicians networks listed, just click on your part of the map to see if there is a network in your area.

STANDARDS VERIFIERS FOR NVQs AND APPRENTICESHIPS

Standards Verifiers for NVQs and Apprenticeships undertake sampling of assessment and internal verification decisions and records to ensure that national occupational standards have been achieved and upheld. They support, advise and guide centres based on the outcomes of the sampling process. They are required to visit their centres twice a year.

To be eligible for this role you must have experience as a NVQ assessor and internal verifier and hold NVQ Assessor and Internal Verifier qualifications - D32/D33, A1/2 awards or equivalent, and D34, V1 or equivalent.

You must also have industrial experience in your specialist subject, formal qualifications, and be familiar with current occupational standards and assessment strategies. To apply for this job please follow the link below:
